IACCP Culture & Psychology Summer School

July 2022 Call for Instructors



Overview

The Culture & Psychology (C&P) School is the educational wing of the International Association for Cross-Cultural Psychology (IACCP). The School has a workshop format and is open to students at Doctoral and Masters levels who are interested in culture and psychology. Workshops are geared toward students of varying levels, from early to advance graduate studies.

The C&P School provides a research-intensive and interactive experience for participants to receive specialized training from experts in the field of psychology and culture. It also provides a stimulating environment for students to learn from each other. The C&P School supports the development of broad research skills, international collaborations, and preparation of scholarly manuscripts. Our goal is to stimulate networking and interactions with peers and instructors in a nurturing and productive environment. We also aim to emphasize the importance of the applied character of research and the necessity of interdisciplinary collaborations.

The C&P School will take place July 3-6 preceding 2022 IACCP online Congress, July 12, 2022—Jul 16, 2022

The program

In 2022, The C&P School has a hybrid format with 1 Stream taking place in person in Europe, potentially in Poland, and 3 Streams taking place online. Students will be able to choose two content streams from four streams as listed below. You will be required to prepare 6 hours teaching and discussion content to be offered in two days (3 hours each day for online sessions).

Instructors are encouraged to submit proposals to the following stream areas. Please note these are some examples of the streams that the C&P Committee has developed (modifications with justifications are welcomed). Please note whether you are open to run your Stream in face-to-face format:

STREAM 1 – Psychological impacts of COVID with a global focus

STREAM 2 -Methodological/ Statistical Stream - Mixed methods, e.g.

- Qualitative and mix method approach
- Ethnographic, observation or interview approaches aligned with quantitative measures
- Possible approaches to writing up mixed method papers

STREAM 3 – Cross-cultural psychology & gender issues:

- Understanding gender across cultures
- Gender & acculturation

STREAM 4 – Clinical psychology or Organizational Psychology from cross-cultural perspectives

Benefits

For face-to-face stream, the C&P School covers economy class airfare up to \$800, accommodations, and food during the one-day C&P school and the cost of registration for the IACCP congress, early bird member rate.

For on-line streams, the C&P School pays \$800 honorarium for each stream and covers the cost of registration for the IACCP congress (early bird member rate). If there are two instructors for one stream the honorarium will be divided and half of the cost of early bird conference registration will be covered for each of the two instructors.

Application Materials

Please send a cover letter describing your stream, why you wish to teach in the C&P School, and your curriculum vitae to cultureandpsychologyschool@gmail.com. Instructors are encouraged in their application to define their topic and their teaching approach clearly and describe how it relates to one of the four streams. It is also encouraged to outline students' learning outcomes and the rationale for teaching in the C&P School. Please also specify your membership status in IACCP.
