

The Convergence Enigma: Electromagnetic Catalysts and the Hidden Architecture of High Strangeness

For decades, UFO and paranormal research have suffered from a kind of intellectual siloing. UFO sightings are categorized on one shelf, poltergeist activity on another, cryptid encounters on still another. Even within MUFON, investigators rightly focus on the aviation, technical, and evidentiary aspects specific to UAPs. Yet witnesses themselves often describe far more than just lights in the sky. They talk about electrical interference, apparitions, time distortions, bizarre creatures, psychic impressions, and overlapping layers of “impossible” phenomena that seem connected but have no established framework.

After years of casework, field investigation, experimenter interviews, and interdisciplinary study, I’ve come to believe these overlaps are not incidental. They are structural.

I call this emerging framework the Convergence Enigma: the hypothesis that UFOs act as electromagnetic catalysts that temporarily alter local environmental conditions, opening the door to dimensional bleed-through phenomena such as poltergeists, cryptids, apparitions, and anomalous cognitive states. These effects are not separate mysteries—they are interconnected expressions of a deeper underlying mechanism.

Below, I outline several historical and modern events where disparate phenomena appear to converge around the presence of UFOs or intense electromagnetic conditions. These “convergence events” form the early architecture of a unifying model—one that may help MUFON investigators capture, document, and interpret high-strangeness data in a more systematic way.



I. The 1972 United Kingdom Convergence: Poltergeist and UFO/Humanoid Encounters

One of the clearest early examples is a little-recognized dual outbreak in the UK in 1972: a poltergeist case in London and a humanoid/UFO encounter in Wales occurring within the same time window. Though geographically separated, both events exhibited striking parallels:

- Sudden onset of incidents following unusual aerial lights
- Intense electromagnetic interference
- Temporary disorientation experienced by witnesses
- Reports of anomalous entities

London: The Poltergeist Outbreak

In London, an otherwise non-haunted home experienced explosive activity: objects thrown, footsteps, disturbances in

electrical appliances, and shadowy figures. Importantly, the events began immediately after residents reported strange lights moving silently over nearby rooftops.

Paranormal investigators noted:

- Electrical surges
- Appliances experiencing power drains or shutting down
- Clocks losing time
- Shadow apparitions correlating with EMF fluctuations

These are precisely the kinds of signatures MUFON investigators see in UFO cases with strong electromagnetic components.

Wales: The Humanoid Encounter

In Wales, around the same period, multiple witnesses encountered a glowing craft and non-human entities.

The effects reported included:

- Engine failure
- Temporary paralysis
- Distorted perception
- Electrical brownouts in the surrounding area

The neurological and environmental markers—especially temporary perceptual distortion—mirror those described by the London family during peak “paranormal” activity.

Why This Matters

Two seemingly unrelated phenomena produced the same physiological, electromagnetic, and perceptual signatures. The simplest explanation is a shared causal mechanism: an electromagnetic event strong enough to induce multiple categories of high strangeness.

This is the core of the Convergence Enigma.

II. Levelland 1957: Vehicle Stalls, Light Beings, and EMF-Induced Anomalies

The Levelland, Texas, wave of 1957 remains one of the strongest EMF-heavy UFO waves in history. What makes it a Convergence Event is not just the vehicle failures—although there were many—but the totality of physiological, atmospheric, and perceptual anomalies surrounding the encounters.

Witnesses reported:

- Complete electrical shutdown of vehicles
- Paralysis or difficulty moving
- Bright blue illuminated entities
- Distorted sense of time

EMF researchers have long noted that strong, transient electromagnetic fields can trigger:

- Hallucination-like perceptions
- Motor disruption
- Static discharges
- Localized atmospheric ionization

Poltergeist literature documents the same phenomenon. Likewise, cryptid encounters—especially those involving glowing eyes, sudden silence, or temporary paralysis—often occur near regions of sudden EM spikes.

Levelland is not just a UFO case; it is a convergence of classic paranormal signatures around a central electromagnetic catalyst.

III. The Kentucky Convergence: Hopkinsville, the Green Men, and Dimensional Overlap

The 1955 Hopkinsville incident is typically categorized as a cryptid case involving “little green goblins.” But when reframed through the Convergence Enigma lens, a broader pattern emerges:

- Witnesses saw a luminous object streak overhead before the entities appeared.
- The creatures demonstrated movement inconsistent with biological animals.
- The environment around the farmhouse displayed “dead calm” moments typical of high-EM conditions.
- Witnesses reported perceptual distortions and disorientation.

If a UFO generated an EM field strong enough to thin or reduce the boundary between dimensional layers, the resulting “entities” could be temporary bleed-through manifestations. Whether those beings were physical, non-physical, or something in between becomes less important than recognizing that the conditions were shared with other convergence cases.

IV. The 1896 Stockton “Paleo-Abduction” and Early Convergence Clues

The Stockton, California, airship encounters (1896) provide a remarkable proto-abduction case long before modern UFO culture existed. What makes this event a convergence?

- Witnesses described strange figures with lanterns—entities both physical and spectral.
- One witness felt a paralysis-like effect.
- Animals in the area were agitated.

- Time perception was distorted.
- The craft emitted an unusual, possibly electrostatic glow.

Without the cultural vocabulary of today, these early witnesses reported what we now recognize as classic UFO and paranormal markers.

The Convergence Enigma suggests that the Stockton case represents one of the earliest documented episodes of EM-induced perceptual bleed-through.

V. Bigfoot/UFO Overlaps: The Creature That Walks Between Worlds

Although MUFON and cryptozoology communities often separate these topics, the witness data show repeated intersection:

- In 1973 Pennsylvania, Bigfoot sightings correlated directly with UFOs seen the same night.
- In Fayette County, witnesses described a glowing orb descending moments before a large hairy creature emerged from the treeline.
- Reports of Bigfoot vanishing, glowing, or exhibiting EM effects (e.g., static electricity, “silence bubble,” battery drain) appear across decades.

The Convergence Enigma interprets these not as biological animals but as intermittent physical manifestations triggered when a UFO or EM anomaly distorts local space.

Cryptids may be as much a side-effect of the convergence as apparitions or poltergeist activity.

VI. The Zanfretta Abductions: Trauma, Electromagnetic Memory, and Cognitive Overlap

The Zanfretta case (1978, Italy) is one of the most complex abduction sequences on record. What is relevant to the convergence model are the repeating signatures:

- Electromagnetic interference during encounters
- Witness amnesia followed by intense recovered memories
- Reports of non-human beings and interdimensional travel
- High-strangeness episodes involving lights, entities, and localized environmental effects

EM researchers propose that strong fields can disrupt hippocampal encoding—leading to memory gaps filled later by reconstructed sensory impressions. This is consistent with both poltergeist experiences and UFO abductions.

If the same environmental mechanism can temporarily alter cognition, perception, and memory, then “haunting” and “abduction” phenomena may share functional similarities.

VII. MADAR, UAP EMF Spikes, and Modern Evidence for the Convergence Theory

Unlike historical cases, we now have instrumentation.

MADAR units across the world detect correlated electromagnetic spikes that frequently align with UAP reports. These spikes occur even when no visible craft is observed. In some cases:

- Witnesses report shadow figures.
- Pets behave erratically.
- People experience sudden anxiety, dizziness, or “presence” sensations.
- Cameras or electronics fail.

This is crucial: EM anomalies often occur without a visible craft yet still produce paranormal-like effects.

This supports the hypothesis that what we call “paranormal” may simply be the human sensory interpretation of dimensional or energetic disruptions created by UAP activity.

VIII. A Unifying Hypothesis: The Electromagnetic Catalyst Model

Based on patterns across hundreds of cases, I propose the following mechanism:

1. UFOs generate strong, variable electromagnetic fields

These fields may be related to propulsion, shielding, communication, or a physical effect we do not yet understand.

2. These fields temporarily distort local spacetime or dimensional boundaries

This could manifest as:

- Visual anomalies
- Apparitions
- Cryptid-like beings
- Poltergeist activity
- Time loss
- Physiological effects
- Emotional or psychic impressions

3. Human perception fills in the sensory gaps

Depending on individual cognition, culture, and physiology, witnesses may experience:

- A UFO
- A ghost
- A creature
- A “presence”
- A manipulation of time or space

4. Multiple phenomena may be occurring simultaneously

A UFO encounter may produce:

- A cryptid sighting
- A haunting
- A poltergeist episode
- An abduction-like experience

All originating from the same catalytic event.

This explains why many experiencers report more than one category of phenomenon across their lives.

IX. The Convergence Enigma as an Investigative Framework for MUFON

MUFON investigators can use the convergence model to broaden evidence collection. When EMF signatures spike or a UFO is sighted, investigators should also document:

- Shadow figures
- Poltergeist-like disturbances
- Cryptid sightings
- Sudden emotional states or intuitive impressions
- Electronic failures
- Animal reactions
- Time distortions
- Physical sensations (pressure, static, tingling)

These data points are often dismissed because they fall outside traditional UFO criteria. But if the Convergence Theory is correct, they may be the most important indicators of the underlying mechanism.

Conclusion

The UFO phenomenon does not exist in isolation. It appears at the crossroads of multiple dimensions of human experience—physical, electromagnetic, psychological, and perhaps interdimensional. What we categorize as ghosts,


cryptids, or psychic impressions may not be separate mysteries at all but different expressions of the same catalytic force: the electromagnetic impact of UAPs interacting with the human perceptual system and the local environment.

The Convergence Enigma is an invitation—to MUFON, to investigators, and to experiencers—to consider a unified map of high strangeness. If we follow the convergences rather than the categories, we may finally begin to understand the architecture underlying the phenomena we have chased for more than 75 years.

Neuro-Ocean: Toward an Enhanced Consciousness Inspired by the Dolphin?

The dolphin is frequently mentioned in abduction reports. More than just a friendly marine mammal, it appears to be an ideal biological interface—a being of profound mystery, perhaps designed for connection and study.

What if dolphins weren't merely intelligent aquatic creatures, but rather a biologically advanced model—perhaps even a bridge—toward non-human consciousness? This article explores a bold hypothesis: The idea that a program—real or speculative—may exist to transpose certain cognitive and neurological abilities of the dolphin onto the human being, notably its capacity to sleep with only one brain hemisphere at a time, in pursuit of enhanced cognitive performance—or even biological militarization.

Here, we weave together biological data, historical facts, the unconventional work of Dr. John C. Lilly, and lesser-known ufological elements to explore a marginal yet fascinating path.

Unihemispheric Sleep: A Marine Superpower

The dolphin, like some bird species, exhibits a unique neurological trait: It sleeps with only one brain hemisphere at a time, while the other remains alert.

Associated functions:

- Maintaining conscious breathing (dolphins breathe voluntarily)
- Monitoring surroundings (predators, environmental changes)
- Slow, minimal movement even during rest

This biological mechanism is efficient, energy-conserving, and highly adaptive, allowing dolphins to survive in extreme environments.

Possible implications: For humans, developing a similar ability could allow prolonged wakefulness without total sleep deprivation, preserving a baseline of rest and vigilance.

Military Programs and Hidden Research

The U.S. Navy Marine Mammal Program, active since the 1960s, has employed dolphins in undersea detection missions, object retrieval, and swimmer defense.

But beyond the official narrative lie lesser-known areas of investigation:

- Studies of sonar-based communication (3D spatial awareness through sound)
- Group coordination without structured language
- Constant alertness and instinctive navigation

Persistent rumors include:

- The existence of experimental sites such as AUTECH, in the Bahamas—sometimes dubbed the “underwater Area 51”
- Secret studies aiming to transplant dolphin-like cognitive properties into humans, particularly related to sleep cycles, conscious awareness, and echolocation

John C. Lilly: Between Science and Metaphysics

No serious exploration of dolphins and consciousness can ignore the controversial yet brilliant Dr. John C. Lilly. A neuropsychiatrist by training, Lilly fearlessly explored the edges of psychophysiology and consciousness, diving between animal language and cosmic awareness.

Key contributions:

- Pioneering use of sensory isolation tanks, enabling deep altered states of consciousness—sometimes akin to lucid dreaming, sometimes something far beyond.
- The use of psychoactive substances (LSD, ketamine) to enhance inner perception, boost intuition, and—in his view—enable interspecies communication.
- A visionary claim: Dolphins may not just be smart, they may be conscious planetary cohabitants, possibly more emotionally balanced than humans.

And then there's his nearly science-fictional idea: ECCO—the Earth Coincidence Control Office—which Lilly de-

The implant, in this scenario, would not be a technological foreign body, but a biological frequency adjustment—a resonance aligned to a collective aquatic consciousness.

Conclusion: The Dolphin as a Living Vector of Contact?

What if dolphins weren't just fascinating animals, but biological ambassadors to a broader consciousness?

Their ability to exist between two realms (wake/sleep, sea/air), their empathic and communal intelligence, and their perception through sound all hint at a balance humanity is still striving to attain.

Perhaps what we call an “implant” isn't a chip at all...but a vibration. And the dolphin, a silent guide toward a new ecology of mind. ●

scribed as a non-local intelligence network subtly influencing events through synchronicities, nudging humans toward higher alignment.

In this framework, dolphins are not subjects of study, but partners, guides, and transmitters of ancient wisdom. Lilly even claimed to have been “guided from within” at certain moments of his life. Coincidence? Synchronicity? Or something deeper?

UFOS, Aquatic Entities, and Occult Transhumanism

Let's move beyond the classic airborne abduction narrative. Hidden beneath the oceans—and social taboos—are lesser-known testimonies of aquatic contact: immersive, fluid, and deep. Water, the planet's primal medium, may also be the scene of unconventional encounters.

Reported phenomena include:

- Conscious fusion with dolphins or marine beings, often during hypnosis or ultra-lucid dreams
- Entities described as part-human, part-aquatic, with heightened empathy and cognition, often bearing ecological messages
- Secret bases, possibly co-occupied by humans (military?) and advanced aquatic beings, located in hard-to-access regions—submerged plateaus or tectonic zones

Here's a disturbing but intriguing idea: What if certain covert programs are already exploring a bio-inspired transhumanism, integrating attributes from non-human life into the human species? Not microchips—but cognitive templates, enhanced senses, and functions such as echolocation or... unihemispheric sleep.

From this perspective, the dolphin becomes more than a model—it is a living prototype of a parallel humanity, or perhaps a missing link between ourselves and an Other.

EMPOWERING MUFON INVESTIGATORS WITH REAL-TIME DATA

For decades, you and I and every dedicated Field Investigator in this organization have been stuck in a frustrating cycle of retrospective investigation. We are the detectives arriving at the scene long after the crime has been committed, the perpetrators have fled, and the witnesses have gone home.

We receive a CMS report days, weeks, or sometimes years “after the fact.” We interview the witness, but we know the uncomfortable scientific truth: Human memory is malleable. It degrades. The moment an event ends, the brain begins shedding details or filling in gaps with imagination. By the time we begin to investigate, the object is long gone, and we are left trying to reconstruct a moment in time based on fading recollections and, if we are lucky, a grainy, singular photo.

That delay is the enemy of science.

As a former MUFON Field Investigator, programmer by trade, and UFO experiencer with a life-long passion to find

the truth, I have spent years analyzing this bottleneck. I realized that if we want to move from “anecdote” to “evidence,” we must stop archiving history and start capturing data while it is happening. We need to shift from a reactive stance to a proactive one

The UFO-Track Service

This realization is the genesis of UFO-Track, a new network designed not to replace MUFON’s forensic excellence, but to act as the “first responder” system that enhances deeper investigation where possible.

To understand the philosophy behind UFO-Track, imagine it is the evening of March 13, 1997, in Phoenix, Arizona. A colossal, silent, V-shaped craft is drifting over the city. Those lucky enough to just look up, stare in awe. Very few have the time or even the thought to grab a camera or camcorder. The resulting evidence is well known, but it remains sparse, shaky, and debated to this day.

Now, imagine a different scenario using today's technology.

The moment the first credible report is made, or the instant a specialized sensor detects a magnetic anomaly, hundreds of phones buzz in pockets across the Phoenix metro area. The message is simple: "Anomaly detected. Look up. Be ready."

Within seconds, hundreds of prepared citizens are outside. They aren't just looking; they are already documenting. They are recording video from multiple angles, time-stamped and geo-located. An isolated, debatable anecdote instantly becomes a verified, data-rich event.

This is no longer science fiction. This is the functionality we have built into the UFO-Track network.

The Power of the Real-Time Network

While we have developed specialized hardware (which I will discuss shortly), I want to emphasize the true power of this project lies in the social network. You do not need our hardware device to be a critical node in this system.

The core of the project is the ability to alert our members/investigators within a 50-mile radius of a sighting as it unfolds. We focus on real-time speed for several critical reasons:

Memory Integrity

As mentioned, the sooner a witness records an observation, the less likely it is to be distorted.

The Network Effect


A single witness often lacks scientific credibility in the eyes of investigators and the public, and even good sighting data is quickly dismissed. But if we can instantly alert a local network, we turn a single sighting into a multi-witness event. Credibility skyrockets.

Multi-Video Analysis

Even with poor quality video taken by the phone in everyone's pocket today, two or more videos of an object from different locations can enable 3D analysis of distance, size, velocity, and acceleration—data far beyond the norm that has been elusive to obtain in the past.

The Rapid Report Form

We have created a streamlined reporting tool available on any smartphone, at <https://report.ufo-track.com>. Our rapid form is designed for ultimate speed. You pre-fill your location and email, so when you see something, it takes seconds to notify the system. (Member reports alert instantly, non-member reports require vetting.)



Once a report is filed, it populates a worldwide map in real time. Anyone can view this map at <https://sightings.ufo-track.com>. If you are a member of the network service and you live near that event, you get a text alert. As this service expands, we can potentially predict the direction of motion of an anomalous object and alert members ahead of the object's path.

Automating the Watch: The UFO-Sense Device

We know that even the most dedicated investigator cannot watch the sky 24/7. This is where my background in programming and electronics comes into play. We developed UFO-Sense, a consumer electronics device designed to automatically detect subtle shifts in the Earth's magnetic field or its gravitational acceleration.

UFO-Sense is a dedicated monitor that sits quietly on a shelf in your home, connected to your WiFi. It monitors the environment for magnetic or gravitic anomalies.

UFO-Sense is constantly vigilant, sending an instant text whenever a shift in magnetic fields is detected.

If you study the historical record, particularly reports from military pilots, a pattern emerges. When UAPs are in close proximity, compasses spin as magnetic fields distort. UFO-Sense scans continuously for these shifts. If it detects one, it doesn't just beep in your empty living room, it sends an instant text alert to you (wherever you are) and notifies the local network.


By utilizing the latest in sensor technology, we have managed to keep the cost of this device around \$100. However, I want to reiterate: Owning the device is optional. The human network, the eyes on the skies, is the most sophisticated sensor system we have.

The Science: Triangulation and the “No-Fly Zone”

Why are we so obsessed with getting multiple eyes on the target? It comes down to basic geometry.

For years, we have been frustrated by the “best UFO picture ever,” which usually turns out to be a bright light against a black background, making it nearly impossible to determine size, distance, or speed. Is it a drone at 500 feet or a craft at 50 miles?

As UFO-Track increases the odds that two or more members capture video of the same object from different locations, we can use stereoscopic 3D analysis to




UFO-Sense text provides detailed information.

mathematically calculate the object’s distance and altitude. This is valuable information, no doubt, but we can go one better. This allows us to explore the concept of the “No-Fly Zone.”

Consider this: No conventional aircraft or high-altitude balloons fly above approximately 20 miles altitude (the upper limit of buoyancy and air-breathing engines). Conversely, satellites do not orbit below about 100 miles (due to atmospheric drag).

This leaves, at minimum, an 80-mile band of altitude, the “No-Fly Zone,” where the only things traversing are rocks (meteors) and rockets.

If our network can provide the data to triangulate an object hovering or maneuvering within this zone, we have scientifically proven it is not a normal plane, balloon, or satellite. It is an anomaly demanding an explanation. This is the kind of hard data that leads to disclosure.



A Partnership: UFO-Track and MUFON

It is vital to understand how UFO-Track views its relationship with MUFON. We are not competitors: We are complementary forces.

Think of UFO-Track as the emergency response system. Our job is immediate detection, rapid alert, and data capture during the event. We are the triage unit.

Think of MUFON as the forensic detectives. MUFON’s job is the deep analysis, the witness interviews, the vetting of hoaxes, and the long-term scientific study.

We strongly suggest that, after the adrenaline fades, all significant events captured by the UFO-Track network be reported to MUFON for in-depth study. We want our networked witnesses to provide better data for you, the investigator. We want to hand you a file containing not just a story, but triangulated video, magnetic sensor readings, and verified, time-stamped data from multiple devices, cameras, and witnesses.

Citizen-Led Disclosure

We founded UFO-Track because, like many of you, we are tired of waiting. We are tired of waiting for the government to release a redacted report telling us what we already know. We are tired of the “drip disclosure” from the military-industrial-government complex.

The technology now exists for us to do this ourselves. We have the internet, we have supercomputers in our pockets, and we have affordable sensor hardware. But most importantly, we have each other.

The era of the solitary witness is over. The era of the networked investigator has begun.

Grant was a unique advocate for a kind and humane approach to ufology and the anomalistic side of life. Welcome to a New Year of great science and space discoveries. 2026 brings the return of US astronauts to lunar space. Artemis II is scheduled to launch next month, a historic return to our lunar exploration path. The crew is composed of some amazing NASA astronauts, Reid Wiseman (Commander), Victor Glover (Pilot), and Christina Koch (Mission Specialist), plus Canadian Space Agency (CSA) astronaut Jeremy Hansen (Mission Specialist). Years of training and preparation are about to culminate in an historic journey.

After a successful Artemis I uncrewed mission around the moon in November 2022, we are now ready to return to cislunar space with crew. This is the next stepping stone to a permanent presence on our nearest celestial neighbor. If all goes well with Artemis II, Artemis III will be landing people on the surface for the first time in more than 50 years.

The last time humans were on the moon was Apollo 17, the eleventh and final mission of the Apollo program, the sixth time humans were on the surface. The mission lasted from December 7–19, 1972. Apollo 17 featured the iconic Lunar Roving Vehicle and many scientific objectives. Astronauts Gene Cernan and Harrison Schmitt spent 75 hours on the surface. Schmitt was also the first scientist–astronaut, something that is now commonplace in the NASA astronaut program. When the Apollo program ended, no one thought it would be another 50 years before humans returned. The Apollo program was the inspiration for many scientists and engineers in today's aerospace industry. Our aerospace technology and capability has flourished and we are more than ready to return to the Moon. ●

IN REMEMBRANCE AND HONOR OF
FRED SALUGA
1949–2025

MUFON West Virginia State Director and Pennsylvania Assistant State Director Fred Saluga passed away on December 1, 2025. Fred joined MUFON in Florida in 1996 and worked with Joe Jordan. In 2007, I noticed Fred's name on our member list with a Florida address. I quickly recruited him into Pennsylvania MUFON. When the 2008 Bucks County UFO wave hit, our cases tripled. With the broadcast of Discovery Channel's *UFOs over Earth*, our membership and investigators also tripled. With managing seven states, Fred and Bill Weber were integral in helping me run Pennsylvania, West Virginia, and Delaware MUFON. I promoted Fred to West Virginia State Director and Bill to Delaware State Director, but we always worked as a team conducting training classes and 42 conferences in Erie, Pittsburgh, and Philadelphia from 2008 to 2024. Fred had the "people" skills, and I the manager's skills. Fred and I did a monthly show on public television called *UFOs over Pittsburgh*. After 44 episodes, we moved the show to my house under the name *String Theory of the Unexplained*. In total, we did almost 100 episodes, which are available on YouTube. We made PA MUFON great!

Fred was a character. He would refer to his hometown as Fayetteenam, so I would introduce Fred as the "James Bond of Fayetteenam." His passion for Bigfoot far exceeded his passion for UFOs. We lobbied MUFON to investigate the Bigfoot-UFO connection. Fred would conduct free UFO-Bigfoot conferences in extended rural locations to get the word out. Fred taught a UFO class at a local college, which I have picked up as instructor. Fred, Bill Weber, John Dousette, and I went to many symposiums together, the most fun being in Las Vegas, of course, when we stayed on the Strip at my timeshare. Fred was a good friend and will be missed by many, especially me. I will miss our long drives around the state and our talks on conservative politics, UFOs, and cryptids...

His daughter Leah Saluga wrote this prior to his passing:

My father is truly one of a kind. At 76, he's lived a life defined by selflessness, honesty, and a deep commitment to helping others. Even now, after being diagnosed with acute myeloid leukemia, he continues to inspire everyone around him with his strength and wit. He's been a police chief, CYF [Children, Youth, and Families] investigator, outpatient drug and alcohol counselor, Bigfoot and paranormal investigator. His curiosity and compassion have touched countless lives; he's always been there for people—no matter who they are or what they are going through. Throughout his life, my father has made a huge difference in this world and in so many people's lives. His impact goes far beyond our family—he's been a friend, mentor, and source of hope for so many. This diagnosis has forced him to stop working and relocate to Pittsburgh for treatment, far from his home in West Virginia. Now the time has come that his body is not responding to the treatments: One treatment affects another in not so good ways. So, what it is now is the end of the road for my poppa. He's going to be crossing the rainbow bridge anytime now. Comfort measures only at this time. I do want to also say how very strong and courageous he is through all of this up until he just fell asleep; we were still talking, and laughing, and still handling business. I want to complete his end of life wishes. I want to celebrate his life, to remember all the memories with him. Those cherished moments I'll hold in my heart forever, each one unwrapping a smile. I know that he was loved by many and that's because he loved so many. Thanks in advance.





The Mystery Airships—Past, Present, and Future

Unidentified drones, spotted carrying out suspicious maneuvers for unknown purposes, are today's mystery airships. There are curious similarities between these continuing drone sightings and those of mystery airships reported circa 1896 to 1913 in the run-up to World War One. The very real drone reports of today and misty, uncertain airship stories handed down from another era don't require extraterrestrial explanations. But the new, Earth-built drone swarms now crowding our skies might be setting future conditions for hypothetical ET infiltration. The ET might be attracted to using their smaller craft, disguised as Earth-originating drones, to evade the interest and attention drawn by larger UFOs and USOs.

The great airship flap of 1896–1897 played out across the U.S. when reports of mysterious, dirigible-like flying machines flooded the newspapers. Lots of reports, none ever credibly backed by other sources. But well over a century later, some lingering doubt remains. Maybe there was something there. And maybe the same during the mystery airship flaps of the early twentieth century. Reports of mystery airship sightings in the U.S., Europe and New Zealand prior to World War One can be attributed partly to hoaxes, newly developing dirigible technology and public imagination. But a residue of doubt remains.



Maybe there was something else present that's never been explained. And now there are the twenty-first century drones...

Reports continue of suspicious drone activities in the U.S. and Europe that seem apart from known military operations. They can't be dismissed like the mystery airship reports of earlier times. Savvy modern witnesses and media demand attention. (See "The 1896 Excuse," *MUFON Journal*, February 2025.) So, we now have reports of old-time mystery airships and modern, mysterious drones that share similarities.

To the extent some old airships reports might have described actual flying machines, they resembled new but known technology of their times. Today's drones are definite modern technology. If the mystery airships were real, their origins and purposes have never been ascertained. The origins, and motives, behind sometimes mysterious modern drone reports are unknown at least to the public. Let's consider one idea that links these eras.

In 1953, the CIA's Robertson Panel issued its report dismissing UFO sightings. But it did consider "Potential Related Dangers," including that frivolous UFO claims could bring on "overloading of emergency reporting channels with 'false' information'... our capability of detecting hostile activity will be reduced." Looking to the future, amid fast-growing security concerns over drones and ever-continuing reports of UFO and USO activity, perhaps the Robertson warning could be turned upside down.

An overload of suspicious, alarming done sightings originating here on Earth might blot out detection of drone-like activities carried out by compact, extraterrestrial spacecraft in disguise. The mystery airship saga continues in modern form. If there were no extraterrestrial craft involved in it before—e.g. disguised as dirigibles—then our aerospace technology may be reaching the point where it becomes easy for them to mix in now. ●


